RULE 26. Effective Date; Repeal; Amendments

- (A) The original rules took effect on the 1st day of October, 1973, and after such rules were filed with the Supreme Court of Ohio in accordance with Civil Rule 83 and Criminal Rule 57. They govern all proceedings in actions brought after they take effect and also all further proceedings in actions then pending, except to the extent that in the opinion of the Court their application in a particular action pending upon the effective date hereof, would not be feasible, would work injustice, with the Rules of Superintendence, the Rules of Civil or Criminal procedure.
- (B) All former rules of this Court are repealed as of the effective date hereof with respect only to the subject matter of those topics herein contained. All revision effective dates shall be notated at the end of each local rule.
- (C) Amendments and additions hereto may be made from time to time upon the majority affirmative vote of all the judges in office of the general divisions of this Court, but such amendments shall not be effective until filed with the Supreme Court of Ohio in accordance with Civil Rule 83 and Criminal Rule 57.
