**Municipal Civil RULE XXIX**

**PROCEDURE FOR OBJECTION TO MAGISTRATE'S DENIAL OF AFFIDAVIT OF  
INDIGENCY**

1. OBJECTIONS:

A party may file written objections to the magistrate's decision denying an Affidavit of Indigency pursuant to R.C. 2323.311 within 14 days under Civ. R. 53(D)(3)(b), regardless of whether the court has adopted the decision. Objections shall be specific and state with particularity the grounds of objection.

2. REQUESTS FOR FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

Requests For Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law regarding a magistrate's decision denying an Affidavit of Indigency **are deemed unnecessary** upon Motions made pursuant to this Rule.

3. RULING ON OBJECTIONS:

The court shall promptly rule on any objections. The court may adopt, reject or modify the magistrate's decision, hear additional evidence, or try the matter *de nova*. The court may refuse to consider additional evidence proffered upon objections unless the objecting party demonstrates that with reasonable diligence the party could not have produced the evidence for the magistrate's consideration.
